＜全体講評＞ 英語で書かねはならない設問が3題あり、しかも内容をしっかりとおさえられていないと書けないものになっていて、受験生は面食らったと思われる。英作文以外の問題をいかに正確にこなせるかが合否のポイントになろう。特に大問Ⅲはほぼ満点が要求されるだろ。

問5 At first, the story-teller shows listeners the situation where the person ‘I’ was depressed by using negative expressions, and makes them predict some terrible ending, but by deploying a Crystal Ball strategy, the story-teller gives an unexpected happy ending.

Ⅱ (1) The “Elephant” is letting listeners understand the trouble where the main character is by telling about his conditions such as no money, no gas and so on, and conveys his next action, because according to the text, the “Elephant” is presenting listeners clearly the situation and background of the story and how the story develops from now on, and in this case the story-teller refers to how the main character tries to solve his problem.

(2) The author's "five-second moment" is not so much dramatic events in our life as trivial things in our daily life, which can be called our turning point in life with hindsight. Mostly dramatic events seem impressive to you, to be sure, but to others they are not so intriguing. Something like a life-altering event touches listeners deeply.
